







Kandy is one of the most scenic cities in Sri Lanka, located 116km from Colombo, at an altitude 465 m above sea level and encircled by hills. Considered as the Hill Capital of the country, Kandy was the last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings and retains an appearance of grandeur. It is the site of the renowned "Temple of the Tooth" and the Royal Botanical gardens home to one of the best collections of Orchids. Cinnamon Citadel Kandy is steeped in historical splendour, with the resort itself being built on the grounds of an ancestral royal home. #### 24 Deluxe rooms (528 sq ft)


The location of these rooms exemplifies the peace and solitude of the surroundings and is situated in the new wing of the hotel with choice of views either of the garden or the river beyond.










### Conference




