### How to Get There

**BY AIR** Brisbane Airport is the gateway to South East Queensland. Direct flights operate from all Australian capital cities and major regional centres. Sunshine Coast Airport is located approximately 12 kilometres from Maroochydore. Qantas and Jetstar operate direct flights from Sydney. Jetstar operates direct flights from Melbourne and Adelaide. Virgin Australia operates direct flights from Sydney and Melbourne.

Fraser Coast Airport is located at Hervey Bay with direct flights from Sydney operated by Virgin Australia and from Brisbane with QantasLink. Toowoomba, the gateway to Southern Queensland Country, is located 125km west of Brisbane and is

easily accessed by Brisbane West Wellcamp Airport. QantasLink flies daily to Toowoomba from Sydney with connections from other capital cities.
